## GOLDWATER SCHOLARSHIP

Recognizes the top undergraduates nationally pursuing research careers in a science, technology, engineering or math (STEM) field. Scholars receive funding for their final year(s) of undergraduate study, and are well-positioned for graduate school applications and awards.

### WHO SHOULD APPLY?

Outstanding undergraduate students with the talent, passion, and preparation to become leading researchers in STEM fields.

Goldwater Scholars typically have:

- High GPA (usually about 3.8)
- Strong research experience
- A record of publishing and/or presenting their research
- Plans to pursue advanced degrees, usually the Ph.D.

### TO BE ELIGIBLE, YOU MUST

- Be a U.S. citizen, national, or permanent resident
- BE a STEM major
- Have 1-2 years of full-time undergraduate study remaining (be a current sophomore or junior)
